JUNIOR POLICE ACADEMY 2009

For Boys & Girls Entering 6th, 7th & 8th Grades

June 15-19, June 22-26 or June 29-July 3

Each session of the Junior Police Academy provides a glimpse of what it means to serve Scotts Valley as a police officer. Through daily interaction with police officers, students learn teamwork while accomplishing learning objectives. During their week, students will learn the importance of physical fitness. They will be introduced to crime scene investigation, patrol tactics, self-defense, arrest techniques and first aid. Students will also spend one day on a low-element challenge course (www.mtcross.org) to further develop teamwork and confidence.

*Enrollment is limited to 16 students per session, so sign up early!**

Sessions run from 8:00 a.m. to noon Monday through Friday. We will meet promptly each morning at the picnic area of McDorsa Park (lower police parking lot) unless otherwise directed for the challenge course. The cost for each session is \$50.00 per student and will include the fees for the challenge course, a tee-shirt and daily snacks.

*Payment is due in full at the time of registration and must be received no later than June 5, 2009. While space is on a first-come basis, priority may be given to those who have not participated in the past.
